Steven M. Baxter of the Ancient Order of Hibernians, Father Solanus Casey Division #32 is our 2023 Grand Marshal of the annual Saint Patrick's Day Parade. Steve was born in NYC, spent his youth growing up in Jackson Heights, NY. He attended Our Lady of Fatima Grammar School, Holy Cross High School, and St. Johns University. Steve graduated in 1990 from American Academy-McAllister Institute of Funeral Service where he received his degree in Mortuary Science.

Steve and his wife Joann reside in River Edge with their twin boys, Sean & Christopher. In addition to spreading the cause for Fr. Solanus Casey's Sainthood, Steven currently serves as the President of the Ancient Order of Hibernians, Bergen Division #32. He is a member of The Council of Irish Associations of Greater Bergen County, The Bergen Irish Association and The County Leitrim Society of New York, as well as an active member of Msgr. Burke 5051 Knights of Columbus and a 4th Degree Knight of Msgr. Charles G. McCorristin Assembly 1289. Steven was the Assistant Cub Master in River Edge NJ. Currently Steven is an Assistant Scout Master in charge of Lower Rank Advancement, and a First Aid, Emergency Preparedness, Public Health, Scholarship, Genealogy and Cycling Merit Badge Counselor for 3 Rivers District and River Edge Troop 184 where his sons are scouts.

Mary has won several awards for a series she did for the Bergen Record about a survivor of domestic abuse using government services to get life back on track for her and her family. Additionally, Mary was awarded a regional Emmy for her talk show "Real Life" on the Comcast television network.

Mary and James enjoy spending time with their children Matthew, Michael, Tom, and Maeve, including four grandchildren: Liam, Eloise, Madeline, and Connor McQueeney.

While Mary's DNA tests show that she is overwhelmingly Irish and her birth grandparents the offspring of Irish immigrants, it is this Irish heritage that has shaped her life since she was a little girl. Kaleigh currently attends the University of Scranton, majoring in accounting and philosophy. Declan is a junior at Bergenfield HS, actively participating in music and volleyball.

Dr. Timmons obtained his Bachelor of Music from William Paterson University, a Master of Arts from Hofstra University, and a Doctor of Music Education from Liberty University. He is currently the Director of Bands and District Music Coordinator at Bergenfield Public Schools. Brian is the President of the North Jersey Band Festival Association and has served as Treasurer and Past President of the Music Educators of Bergen County, Inc. In 2013, Brian was named by Yale University Distinguished Music Educator (New Jersey representative), in 2018 Fifty Directors Who Make a Difference - School Band and Orchestra Magazine (NJ rep), and in 2022 received the John Philip Sousa National Honor Band Faculty Award. Brian has directed marching bands in two major motion pictures (Bounty Hunter and Tower Heist) and coordinated marching activities during the Super Bowl 48 Halftime Show.

Dr. Timmons' support of the Council of Irish Associations of Greater Bergen County transcends over 20 years, as a participant and a marching band recruiter for the St. Patrick's Day Parade. Brian is the Founder and Artistic Director of Youth Wind Ensemble of Greater Bergen County, which will be traveling to Ireland in the summer of 2024 for a concert tour.

At her core is her family, and her faith where she extends her spirit to giving back to St. John the Evangelist of Bergenfield, the Missionary Franciscan Sisters of Tenafly, and the Society of African Missions of Tenafly.

Bernadette is proud to serve as a 2023 Aide for the Bergen Irish to the Grand Marshal. She is a Trustee of the Bergen County Council of Irish Associations and always welcoming to new joiners in navigating the wonderful Member Organizations. Bernadette first became involved with Bergen County's vibrant Irish community, where she has made lifelong friends, through her membership with the Irish American Social Club, and the Bergenfield School of Irish Dance. She then joined the Bergen Irish Ladies, serving as Vice President for four years. As a devoted member of the Bergen Irish, Bernadette relishes the company of her fellow members, and proudly celebrates her beloved Irish culture at their many events. She hopes the next generation of Irish Americans will continue to celebrate and hold dear Irish traditions and the welcoming spirit of the Irish.

A native of lovely Leitrim, Bernadette attended Mohill Vocational School, then worked in an Accountant's office in Longford. In 1958, she emigrated to the United States and joined the New York Telephone Company for ten years, serving as Supervisor. In 1968, Bernadette married John McCabe, also of lovely Leitrim. They lived with their four daughters in Woodside, Queens until moving to Bergenfield in 1984. Bernadette then became involved in St. John's church, including outreach to the homeless. Bernadette was a part time secretary at the Bergenfield School System, and Office Manager at St. John's Religious Education Office.

Bernadette worked for ten years for the Interreligious Fellowship for the Homeless (now Family Promise). She was Office Manager before her retirement. She was Coordinator providing meals to 150 people and still helps with these efforts. She remains a strong advocate for improving the situation of the Homeless in Bergen County. She was especially committed to Peter's Place, a drop-in shelter at Christ's Church in Hackensack, and St. Cecilia's Family Shelter, providing dinners and overnight stays for homeless families. As part of St. John's Social Concerns Committee, she was instrumental in relocating two families from war torn Kosovo to Bergenfield and Dumont over twenty years ago.

Bernadette volunteered at Sister Trinity's Gift Shop in Tenafly, and after Sister passed away in 2017, she kept the Shop open for one more year with the help of great volunteers and managed the closing of the shop. During the early stages of the pandemic, she helped to obtain difficult to find medical essentials for the Sisters. She remains a loyal friend and supporter of the Sisters.

Bernadette and John are blessed to be happily married for over 54 years. They enjoy spending time with their family, including nine grandchildren: Debbie and Brendan Daly (River Edge), Kathleen and Dana LaForge (Rye and NYC), Tara and Michael Kelly (Spring Lake), and Bernadette and Bill Kelly (Allendale). 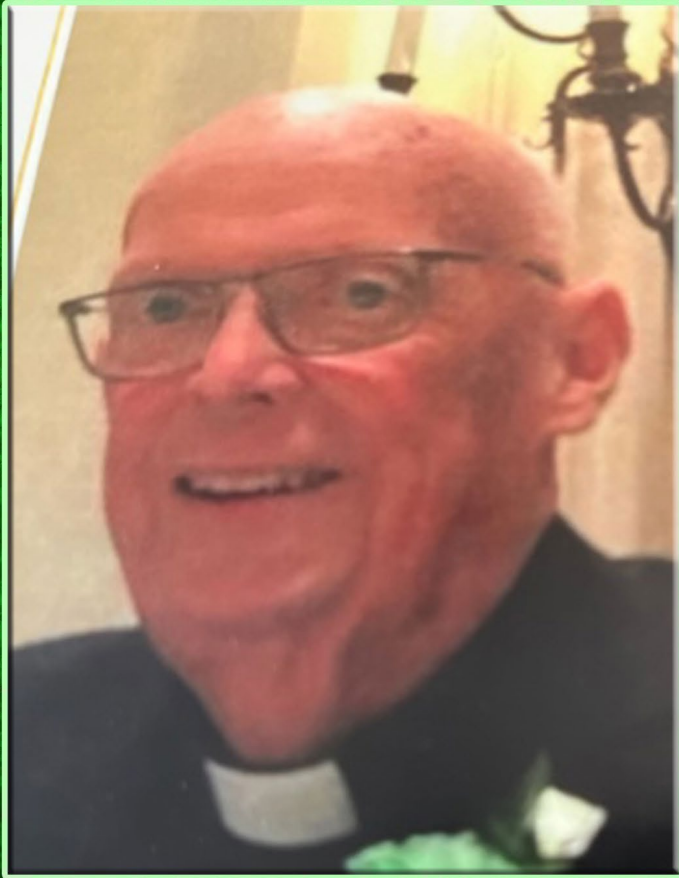
Patrick F. Heenev was born and raised in East Rutherford, New Jersey and attended St. Joseph's grammar school. The youngest of five siblings of Pat and Anna Heenev who immigrated to the United States in 1953 with their two daughters Mary and Patricia Frances (and Thomas and Albert), at age fourteen Patrick relocated to attend High School in Tenafly, NJ then attended Pace University graduating from the Pleasantville NY campus with a Bachelor of Business Administration degree and passed the Certified Public Accountants exam to gain his CPA license.

Patrick worked in New York City for 12 years with a large middle market firm called Mazars USA and then continued at the Liz Claiborne Corporation during its heyday in the 1980s–1990s. Since 2014, he has served as a partner in the CPA firm of Steven T Cirillo, CPA LLC in Westwood, New Jersey, specializing in individual and small business tax return preparation and serving clients within the non-profit sector.

Patrick's father was born and raised in Balbriggan, County Dublin, and his mother in Drogheda, County Louth. His father was the grand marshal of the 1994 St. Patrick's Day Parade in Bergenfield and was also a member of the Council of Irish Associations in the early days of its formation, as well as a founding member of the North Jersey Irish American Association in East Rutherford, New Jersey in 1972. Continuing Irish traditions growing up, Patrick played a full-forward position on the Gaelic football squad for St. Brendan's in Kearney, New Jersey.

For ten consecutive years, Patrick has served as the Master of Ceremonies of the Bergenfield St. Patrick's Day Parade. True to his heritage as a performing musician since the age of 18, Patrick is the guitarist in Jackson and Johnson, an acoustic duo act, and also the bass player in the Irish/American band NineMile House, who performed during the summer of 2022 in the Catskills East Durham Irish Festival and at Gavinstock at Gavin's Irish Country Inn.

Patrick is currently the Vice President and was a former Financial Secretary on the Executive Board of the Council of Irish Associations of Greater Bergen County, Inc., and is a member of the Knights of Columbus in Ridgewood, NJ.

Fr. Stephen A. Carey was born and raised in Kearny, NJ where he attended St. Stephen's grammar school and Kearny High School. Next, Fr. Carey attended The University of Pennsylvania where he earned his undergraduate degree in Biology. After finishing his degree, Fr. Carey remained at UPenn serving in a number of administrative positions, including Assistant Director of Transportation and Parking in the Office of Business Services, Director of Community Relations in the Office of the President of the University and Special Assistant for Community Development in the Office of the Treasure.

Fr. Carey decided to answer God's call and entered Immaculate Conception Seminary at Seton Hall University. After completing the Program for Priestly Formation, Fr. Carey was ordained a priest of the Archdiocese of Newark, NJ on May 23, 1998.

As a Parochial Vicar, Fr. Carey has served in Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Parish in Roseland, NJ, and St. Mary's Parish in Dumont, NJ. After less than a year in Dumont, Fr. Carey was named pastor of the Church of the Madonna in Fort Lee, where he presided over a busy bilingual (English/Korean) parish which also hosted a successful grammar school and has a large parish cemetery.

After serving for 10 years as pastor at the Church of the Madonna, Fr. Carey was granted a six-month sabbatical during which he participated in the sabbatical program at the Pontifical North American College in Vatican City. After finishing his sabbatical, Fr. Carey returned to Dumont as the pastor of St. Mary's where he has served for the past 7 years.
