KIERAN LYNCH NAMED AS 2022 GRAND MARSHAL

Kieran Lynch named as 2022 Grand Marshal for Bergen County Saint Patrick's Day Parade in Bergenfield, NJ

BERGENFIELD, NEW JERSEY, August 2021 - The Council of Irish Associations of Greater Bergen County, Inc., is pleased to announce that Kieran Lynch of the Bergen Irish Association of Dumont, NJ, will be the Grand Marshal of the annual Saint Patrick's Day Parade. The Bergen County Parade has a proud tradition of honoring Saint Patrick, the patron saint of Ireland, and the Irish people of Bergen County.

Currently serving as the Bergen Irish Association President, Kieran has previously served as the Bergen Irish Association's Recording Secretary and as a member of its Board of Trustees. He is the son of founding member Edward Lynch. Kieran's Irish heritage is from Castlegregory, County Kerry; Ballyduff, County Waterford; and Six Mile Bridge, County Clare.

The 40th Annual Bergen County Saint Patrick's Day Parade is expected to take place on Sunday, March 13, 2022. The Council looks forward to the parade following two years of a postponement and a 2021 virtual parade due to COVID-19. Prior to the start of the parade there will be a flag raising at the Roy W. Brown Middle School in Bergenfield, NJ, at 1:00 PM, where Kieran Lynch will deliver his Grand Marshal's address, followed by the Annual Parade March down Washington Avenue at 2:00 PM.
